15 Affordable White Wines From France That Should Be in Your Collection

And they're all available for under \$25.

France may be home to some of the most prestigious, pricey white wines in the world, but it's also a fantastic source for bottles that seriously over-deliver for the money. With spring set to arrive, this is the perfect time of year to reconsider the astounding value that can be found there.

I've tried to focus on somewhat less familiar names here, but that doesn't mean that there aren't countless other worthy options that should absolutely be in regular rotation in your home. The E. Guigal Côtes du Rhône Blanc, for example, is a charming, effusive winner vintage after vintage—and can be found for well under \$20. Others, like the honeysuckle—, pineapple—, and chamomile—kissed Souleil Vin de Bonté Le Blanc 2020 Vin de France, are far less widely distributed (it's available at Convive Wines) yet still worth space on the wine rack. Muscadet, too, is a reliably wonderful wine that tends to over-deliver.
